



HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Licencees must ensure that they are aware of the following conditions and requirements, and that their guests, dependants and employees are fully instructed and inducted into the same:

1. That they are fully inducted into and conversant with all aspects of the operation of their boat prior to its use, its manoeuvring and control limitations, particularly in tight spaces, and with due regard to the safety of other users.
2. That they are not under the influence of alcohol or drugs when operating the boat.
3. That they are aware of the various depths of the inlet channel and mooring basin at mean water level (MWL) and during high water and flood events.
4. That they are aware of the effects of the current at the entrance to the inlet channel, particularly during high water, and the resulting effects on entry and exit to and from the river.
5. That they are conversant with the means of tethering the boat safely and securely to the mooring rings and poles taking into account varying water levels.
6. That they make adequate and safe provision for boarding from and alighting onto the quayside, and that appropriate procedures are in hand in the event of any party falling into the basin or inlet channel.
7. That they carry adequate lifesaving equipment on board, and that all passengers are instructed appropriately into its use.
8. That they carry operable fire extinguishing equipment on board, and that all flammable liquids or other hazardous materials are stored in appropriate containers.
9. That children are kept fully in control, and not left unattended on the boat, or in the vicinity of the inlet or basin.
10. That they hold the telephone numbers and the means in an emergency to contact the Company and Emergency Services without delay.
11. That they carry First Aid equipment on board at all times.
12. That they hold adequate equipment, ropes etc. to tether or secure the boat in abnormal circumstances.
13. That no ropes, equipment or other items are left of the quayside such as to cause a hazard to other users.
14. That pets brought to the Staithe or on board are kept under control at all times.
15. That they remain aware of and protect the safety and well-being of third parties within the Staithe and its surrounds, and Residents of Waterside, at all times.
16. That the Staithe and its surroundings be kept clean of refuse and any polluting substance at all times.
17. That no waste liquid or solids be deposited in the water within the Staithe or in the surroundings.
18. That they carry Third Party Liability Insurance cover of £2,000,000 covering any activities within the boundaries of the Staithe, its surroundings and approaches, and otherwise generally in accordance with the requirements of the Licence for Mooring clauses 3.7.1,2,3 and 3.8.
